## **AIMS & OBJECTIVES**

#### Course aim

There is nothing quite like hand embroidery. Some people use it to 'paint' their canvas or fabric to create the most amazing pictures; whether they are beautiful landscapes, still life or abstract, they are always pieces of textile art. Embroidery stitches and techniques are as old as time itself and I am happy to be able to share some of them with you. You will be able to share this ancient craft to keep this artform alive and kicking! We will be making a little book of stitches, learning two or three stitches each week, and including them in the book. Some pages of your book will be abstract, while others will form a picture or a theme.
