<b>Course</b>	<b>Painterly printmaking with gelli plates</b> Experiment with gelli plates printmaking techniques and design principles to produce your own original artworks.
<b>Tutor/artist:</b>	<b>Pam Cole</b> Visual artist working in different media: printmaking, painting, and collage.

## AIMS & OBJECTIVES

**Course aim** In this course, you will gain hands on experience of a range of painting and printing techniques using gelli plates. You will learn about design principles and how to apply them to your artwork. You will make your own design choices to create your own unique artwork. You will have an opportunity to take part in group discussions about visual design choices of other artists, supporting further creative development.

**Learning** To successfully complete the course, you will:

**Objectives**

1. Attend a minimum of 6 sessions.
2. Reflect on your own learning.
3. Contribute to group discussions.
4. Create a print using monotype techniques.
5. Create a print demonstrating a painting technique.
6. Combine, in the same print, more than one colour or printmaking technique.
7. Design an image using printmaking and collage.
